TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. A completed entry includes this form, fees, and waiver. Failure to submit all three prior to or at the captain's meeting will result in rejection of entry and inability to participate.
- 2. Participants must leave from and return to any dock or public landing in Beaufort County. There will be a maximum of six Anglers per boat, including youth (under 15).
- 3. All fish must be caught with hook and line and landed in a sporting manner. No nets, dynamite or guns, etc. No mutilated fish allowed.
- Lines will be in the water no earlier than 6:00 AM May 11 OR 18, 2024. Scales open at 3:00 PM, all fish must be weighed by 5:00 PM at the Port Royal Sands.
- 5. All anglers on each boat can only weigh in fish on the tournament date of their choice.
- All fish must be caught in public waters or offshore, no impoundments, ponds, lakes or private waters.
- Each angler may enter only one fish per species. All anglers MUST BRING THEIR OWN fish to be weighed.
- In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by the <u>EARLIEST</u> weigh-in time.
- 9. All protests or grievances must be submitted in writing to the weigh-master, with a \$100 protest fee within 15 minutes of the scale closing.
- 10. The fishing tournament committee is the final arbiter of any disputes.
